

Child Care Program For Ages 2 - 4

Enrollment and Fees To register, return a signed Parent Agreement, completed Enrollment Form, and a nonrefundable fee of \$50 per child for the school-year (\$10 for summer enrollment only). For two or more children from the same family, the enrollment cost is \$75. **Each child may enroll for up to two days per week.**

A fee of \$35 per day will be charged per child. If two children from the same family are enrolled in the program on the same day, the fee will be \$55 per day; three children will be \$75 per day.

Each child may enroll for up to two days per week. Payment is due at the beginning of each month. Registration ensures your child's spot at PDO for the school year.

Eligibility

PDO is a community service sponsored by St. Barnabas Episcopal Church. Any families from our surrounding communities are eligible to enroll.

Children ages 2-4 are eligible for the program. All children age three and up must be toilet-trained to attend our program. We do accept children who are two years old in diapers and we work with you to assist with toilet training. (May be waived if special circumstances exist.)

Daily Schedule

9:00: Drop off.
9:00-10:30: Free play, Craft, Circle and Music time.
10:30: Snack and drink.
10:45: Large motor play in gym space and bounce house or on patio (if weather permits.) Potty/Diaper break.
12:00: Lunch.
12: 15: Free play.
12:30: Group story-time .
12:50: Prepare to go home.
1:00pm: Pick up.

Snack/Lunch

A snack will be served at 10:30am each day. Cheerios, pretzels, animal crackers, etc. We are a peanut-free zone. For lunch, children will bring a sack/box from home and their own drink.

Staff

All staff are experienced caregivers, are first-aid and CPR certified, and undergo background checks and safety training.

Safety and Security

Our building doors will remain locked during PDO hours. We will not allow people we don't know into the building. We will not release a child to anyone that is not listed for pickup on their enrollment form.

Our Space

Our main PDO room is a 784 square foot enclosed room full of play areas that include blocks, puzzles, books, art, trains, kitchen, sensory table etc. We have a dedicated area for older 3s and 4s to play and learn. We will also make use of an additional large indoor open space each day for large motor play that includes ride-ons, obstacle courses, slides, climbers, parachutem, and a bounce house. If weather permits, we may play on our patio that has a sand box.
